
## Field Inspection report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Chintur on 01-12-2018 Regarding Diversion of forest land 1.54 Ha. for formation & BT to the road including construction of culverts from Vinayakapuram to Irkampeta village falling in Compartment No.155, E.D.Pally R.F., Kunavaram Range of Chintur Division in favour of Executive Engineer(PR), PIU Division, Kakinada

On 01-12-2018 inspected the proposed area for diversion of forest land 1.54 Ha.for formation & BT to the road including construction of culverts from Vinayakapuram to Irkampeta village falling in Kunavaram Range of Chintur Division. The concerned Panchayath Raj staff and the Forest Range Officer, Kunavaram along with his staff accompanied in the field inspection. The proposed Road length is 2150 Mtrs and width of 6.00 Mtrs. passing through the Compartment No.155, E.D.Pally Forest Block (notified U/s.4 of A.P. Forest Act.1967)of Kunavaram Range.

The proposed Road was already existed as gravel road and using by the local villagers from long back for passing small vehicles for their day to day movements. There is no tree felling involved along the length and width of proposed road and the proposed area falls under the Eco-class III with Eco-value of Dense Forest, and the density of the forests on the proposed width of the road is less than 0.10 density. The details of existing flora in the proposed area for diversion and the adjacent area are Dalberfia latifolia, Choloroxylon switenia, Albizzia odoratissima, Anogeissus latifolia, Diaspyros melanoxyion, Lannea grandis, Madhuca indica.



This project is very useful for the local villagers to connect mandal Head Quarters. The required forest area is unavoidable for the project and due to this project there is no threat to the local flora, fauna and the proposed Forest areas does not fall in any wildlife sanctuary/ National Park, Eco Sensitive Zone. There are no archeological sites of importance and no historical monuments. In the inspected area the User agency did not carry out any work in violation of the provisions of FC Act and other relevant acts.
