Shahapur for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons	<p>The Project Authority has proposed social activities like Goshala and Old age home in their Private lands in G.No. 12, 26/1/2 & 26/1/3 of village Karade owned by the project authority. By using minimum forest land for Construction of approach road this project will be beneficial for the citizens of the Savroli Bk., Karade and nearby areas by providing access to the proposed social activities.</p> <p>The Project Authority tried to construct the Pacca road on the area which was earlier used by the local villagers to communicate to their households. The offence has been booked against the violators, including the Project Authority. The legal action under the provisions of Indian Forest Act, 1927 is in process.</p> <p>The Project Authority has carried out the works in violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and rules made there under, before submitting the proposal for diversion of forest land under the act. Since there is no involvement of fresh cutting of trees and fresh disturbance to the forest in proposed road, the proposal is recommended for acceptance, subject to deposition of five (5) times Net Present Value (NPV) of the violated area by the project authority as directions issued in the Part-B, Chapter I, Rule 1.21 of the Forest (Conservation) Rule, 2003 notified in March 2019.</p>
