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Site inspection report

Lilo of One Circuit TTPS-Govindpur Transmission Line at GSS Jainamore (34.739ha.)

The 220Kv Lilo of one circuit transmission line from TTPS- Govindpur Transmission Line at GSS Jainamore passes through 04 protected forests in Bokaro Forest Division and all the PFs have been inspected on 29.02.2020. Starting from Tarmi PF, the proposed forest land is situated adjoining to Railway Crossing Near Bhandaridaha and the land in highly vulnerable to soil erosion, the next is Rajabera & Chirudih PF which in has devoid of trees, similarly it was observed in the Corresponding PF in Galudih that the forest land is degraded and is having scanty vegetation. However, in both the PFs, the forest land is highly prone to soil erosion.

- * In this landscape, Drongos, Egrets, Flycatchers, Kingfisher, Jacanas, Jungle fowls, Munias, minivets, orioles, Owls, Parakeets, Sand Grouse, Sunbirds, langurs, Common Palm civet, Tree pie, weaver birds are also present.
- * There is no protected, archeological/heritage site in or defense establishment in the area through which the transmission line would be passing.
- * The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col-02 of Part-1 is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project.
- * No work has been carried out in violation of Forest Conservation Act, 1980.
