With reference to the above subject, the Superintending Engineer, Rural Drinking Water & Sanitation Department, Bangalore has submitted proposal for diversion of 8.49 hectares (Revised from 4.939 ha) Drinking Water Supply Scheme to Rural Habitations and Town of Pavagada Taluk in Tumkuru District, Rural Habitations and town of Molakalmuru Taluk in Chitradurga District, Rural Habitations of Challakere Taluk in Chitradurga District, Ujjani & 216 Habitations of Kudligi Taluk in Ballari District, Chilakanahatti & 14 Habitations of Hospet Taluk in Ballari District and Additional Turuvanur & 59 Habitations of Chitradurga Taluk in Chitradurga District, Karnataka State, India vide letter Online Application No. FP/KA/WATER/41470/2019 [FORM-A].

Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Conservation), Bengaluru has scrutinized and forwarded the same to the undersigned in the online portal. The user agency has submitted hard copy of the proposal to this office vide letter under Ref (3). Further, office of the undersigned had directed the user agency to submit the complete proposal for diversion of 8.49 hectares (Revised from 4.939 ha) Drinking Water Supply Scheme to Rural Habitations and Town of Pavagada Taluk in Tumkuru District, Rural Habitations and town of Molakalmuru Taluk in Chitradurga District, Rural Habitations of Challakere Taluk in Chitradurga District, Ujjani & 216 Habitations of Kudligi Taluk in Ballari District, Chilakanahatti & 14 Habitations of Hospet Taluk in Ballari District and Additional Turuvanur & 59 Habitations of Chitradurga Taluk in Chitradurga District, Karnataka State. The same has been submitted by the User Agency through the Assistant Conservator of Forests, Kudligi and Hospet vide letters under Ref(4) & (5).

On perusal of the record submitted and upon personal visit to the proposed site on 22.03.2022 & 08.06.2022, it is observed that proposed forest area falls various of villages in Vijayanagara, Chitradurga and Turnkur Districts and total length of the project is 2681.42 kilometer, out of this 47.50 kilometer length is falling in forest land and width is varying 1.00 mtr to 3.00 mtr i.e. 8.49 hectares.



Further, other significant details facts about the laying of underground Water Pipeline proposal in Vijayanagara District as observed from the proposal documents submitted by the User Agency, report from the field officers and during the site visit are elucidated hereunder;

 Extent of the proposal: Details of area requisitioned for laying of underground Water Pipeline in the proposal are tabulated as following;

2) Net Present Value (NPV): As per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated:28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No. 5-3/2011-FC (Vol.I) dated 06.01.2022.19.01.2022 & 23.03.2022, the User Agency has to pay Net Present Value over an extent of 4.656 hectares. In this regarding, the User Agency has submitted the undertaking to remittance of Net Present Value(NPV).

## 3) Compensatory Afforestation (CA).

The User Agency i.e. the Superintending Engineer, Rural Drinking Water & Sanitation Department, Bangalore has identified following CA land for the Compensatory Afforestation.

4) The User Agency has not submitted the certificate in Form-I under Forest Rights Act-2006. In this regard, the User Agency has requested the Deputy Commissioner, Vijayanagara vide letter Dt 18.05.2022. Crer

5) The proposed pipeline is passing through protected area of Gudekote Sloth Bear Sanctuary (Map enclosed with the proposal). The area of proposed pipeline traverses through is 1.113 ha (3710.40 mtr Length X 3.00 mtr Width). In this regard, the User Agency may be directed to obtain Clearance from the National Board of Wildlife..

Hence, the proposal for diversion of 4.656 hectares for Drinking Water Supply Scheme to Rural Habitations and Town of Pavagada Taluk in Tumkuru District, Rural Habitations and town of Molakalmuru Taluk in Chitradurga District, Rural Habitations of Challakere Taluk in Chitradurga District, Ujjani & 216 Habitations of Kudligi Taluk in Ballari District, Chilakanahatti & 14 Habitations of Hospet Taluk in Ballari District and Additional Turuvanur & 59 Habitations of Chitradurga Taluk in Chitradurga District, Karnataka State is recommended for further approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to Clearance from the National Board of Wildlife.
