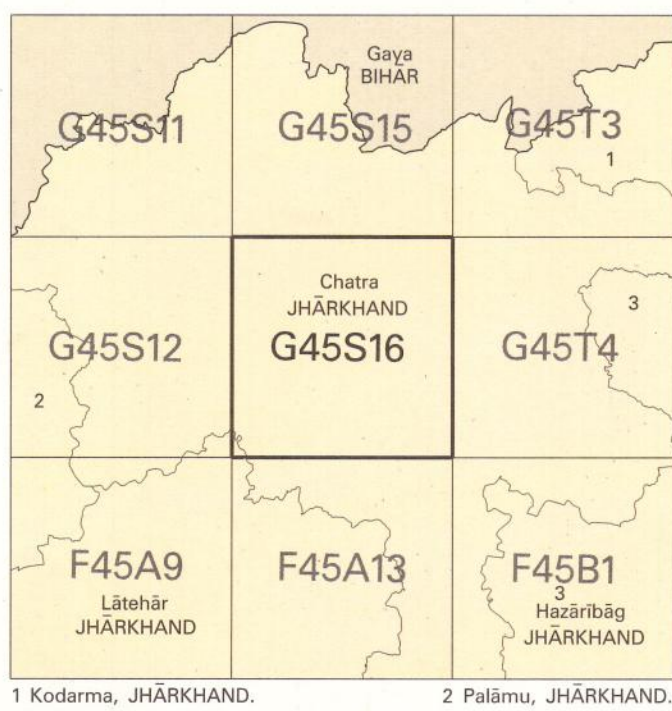

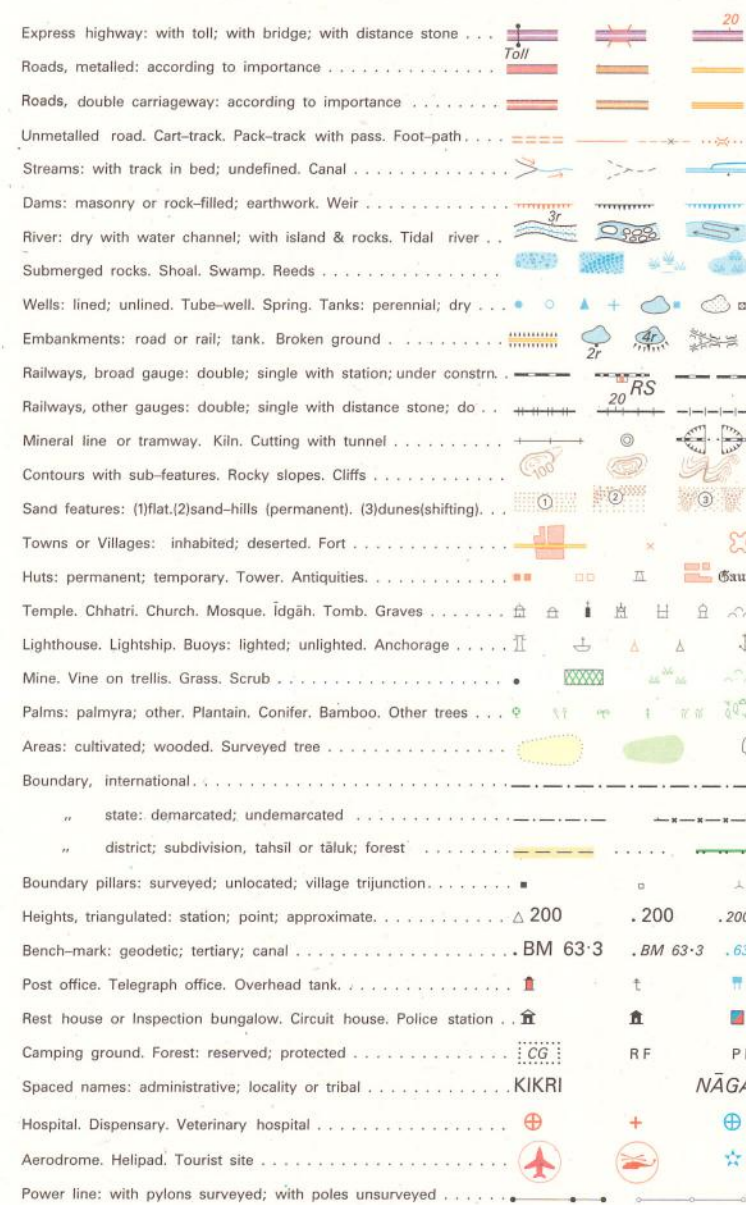
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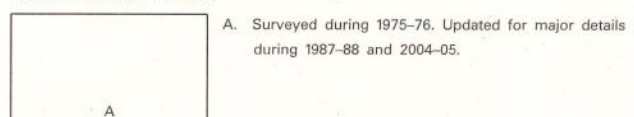

NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
Tanks shown dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to March.
Wells are numerous in squares C/1, 2 and 3, only the important ones have been shown.
Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads, in this sheet, are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those inside forest areas is required from the Forest Authorities.
A relative height, 2r represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads are shown in slant type e.g. '6' whereas milestone numbers, are shown in upright type e.g. '5'.
The common boundary between the Protected Forests are not shown for want of reliable information.

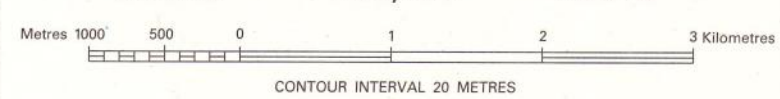
COMPILATION INDEX

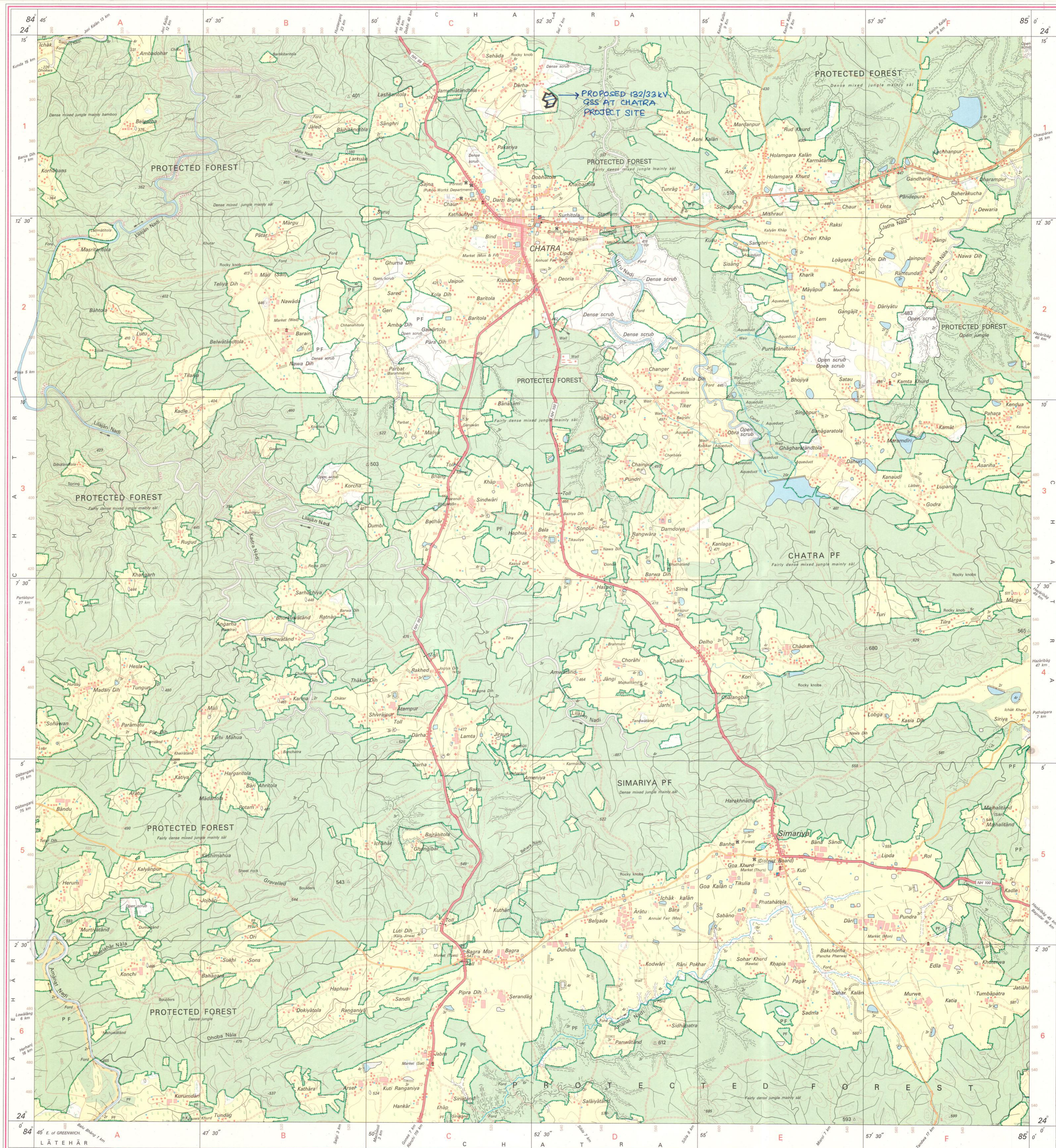


CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 METRES
