

JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT IN GM

Khas /JJ LAND

At present scenario of the Jharkhand state, establishment of a Grid Sub-station (GSS) is very essential in Chatra District as there is no other GSS in this district. Due to unavailability of GSS, there is always a problem of low voltage as well less period of electricity supply. Also coming days there is many industrial bodies are planning for set up plant under Chatra District and nearby areas. Accordingly need of electricity is also going to increase by upcoming years. Accordingly Jharkhand Urja Sancharan Nigam Limited (JUSNL), a Public Sector Enterprise of Govt. OF Jharkhand (GOJ) planned to set up a 132/33kV Grid Sub-station(GSS) near Chatra Town to avoid any power problem and meet the 24X7 electricity target. Accordingly a land of 9.98 acre (GM Khas & JJ) land is identified with NOC from Deputy Commissioner (DC), Chatra to set up this GSS at Darha Village near Chatra Town. During construction of this GSS project it helps to generate employment to the local people directly or indirectly. For this purpose required land is needed for setting up this GSS.

1.3 Cost Incurred

The details of the cost incurred while converting the Non-forest land i.e. GM Khas/JJ for set up 132/33kV Grid Sub-station are given in the following paragraphs.

(a) Project Investment: The capital outlay incurred for the development is estimated = Rs. 35.47 crores


(b) Land Cost: JUSNL has to pay Nil. Forest Dept. Nil.
