In compliance of the ministry of environment and forests (MoEF) Government of India's letter no. 11-9/98 FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement rights under the scheduled Tribes and Others Traditional Forest dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act. 2006 (FRA for short) on the Forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation on respect of linear projects, it is certified that 6.961 Hectares of Forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Chhattisgarh State Power Transmission CO. LTD. For 132 kv. transmission line in Balrampur-Ramanujganj District falls within jurisdiction of Murka, Singchora, Navki, Chilmakala, Rajpur, Chatkpur villages in Rajpur tehsil.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 6.961 Hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee (s), Gram Sabha (s), Sub Division Level Committee(s) and the District level committee are enclosed as annexure.....to annexure.....
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the gram sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognised rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre- agricultural communities.
