In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt), dtd. 3Rd August, 2009 wherein in the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 5(five) hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of KW/33 Besimari Minor Mineral Unit (Sand) in Kulshi and Pantan RF for collection of sand in Kamrup District does not falls within jurisdiction of any forest village (s) in (NA) tehsils.

It is further certified that:-

(a) The completed process for identification and settlement of rights under FRA has been carried out for the entire 5 Ha. of forest land proposed for diversion.
