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Justification letter for Forest Land Diversion for Non-Forest Use

Central Public Works Department (CPWD) has been entrusted for construction of Indo-China Border Roads by the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), Govt. of India in the state of Arunachal Pradesh.

In this connection, the road as detailed below is proposed to be constructed in Tawang District in the state of Arunachal Pradesh for ITBP. The approved alignment of this road (attached herewith) falls in the forest area that needs to be acquired under Forest Conservation Act, 1980.
