


**PRESCRIPTION AS PER WORKING PLAN IN RESPECT OF BELOW

54/G, 55/G, 56/G & 61/G	Chir Irregular Working Circle.	Chir Irregular Working Circle. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Effective closure and strict fire protection measures be adopted. 2. Areas bearing scant crop of Chir be closed against biotic interferences and protection against fire. 3. Supplementation of area with artificial sowing and / or planting. 4. Direct sowing in patches in areas which are unlikely to respond to closure. 5. Protection against fire by constructing fire lines. Control burning should be carried out for disposal of the debris preferably during December to February.

The immediate need to reboise the forest is :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Strict closure to grazing. 2. Inducing natural or artificial regeneration. 3. Planting and sowing of most suited species among conifers. 4. Localities difficult for conifer plantation to be planted with most suitable and economical BL species. <p>B. Planting of degraded forest near and around human settlement with fuel-wood, fruit and fodder yielding plants.</p> <p>C. Intensive Soil Conservation Measures including engineering works.</p> <p>D. Highly degraded and dry sites to be planted with hardy and drought resistance species like, <i>Ailanthus</i> Spp., <i>Prunus</i> and other local species.</p>
52b/G	Deodar Kail Selection Working Circle	Deodar-Kail Selection Working Circle. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The areas near human settlement under severe pressure of grazing should be effectively closed. 2. In case of presence of partial regeneration, the subsidiary measures such as, uprooting and cutting of shrubs, Artificial Regeneration by way of planting be resorted.
70/G	Protection working Circle	Protection Working Circle. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Compete rest. ii. No felling. iii. No resin tapping. iv. Strict control against fires, illicit damage, and encroachment. <p>Protection from excessive grazing.</p>
