


### STATEMENT SHOWING CERTIFICATES FROM A TO H

A.	A letter from the Superintending Engineer, RWS & S Circle, Kurnool certifying that the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire forest area proposed for diversion, with a record of all consultations and meetings held.	The proposed area Diversion of 0.14 Ha. of land for laying of pipe line for drinking water in Compt.No.235, South Dhone Reserve forest, Chintalapeta Beat, Peapully Section of Dhone Range of Kurnool Division does not fall in the Schedule Tribes area and therefore does not attract the provisions of RoFR Act, 2006. Consequent on which, identification and settlement of rights under FRA does not arise.
B.	A letter from the Superintending Engineer, RWS & S Circle, Kurnool certifying that proposals for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular / local languages) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of Forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.	There are no Forest Dwellers in the proposed diversion area, hence, does not arise.
C.	A letter from each of the concerned Gram Sabhas, indicating that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensatory and ameliorative measures if any, having understood the purpose and details of processed diversion.	The Resolution passed by the Gram Panchayat was obtained from the U.Kothapally (V) & Gram Panchayat of Dhone Mandal of Kurnool District duly conducting meeting and required documents / certificates giving their consent to the proposed diversion is submitted. However, there are no claims existing in the area proposed for diversion.
D.	A letter from the Superintending Engineer, RWS & S Circle, Kurnool certifying that the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been complied and that the Gram Sabha have consented to.	Does not arise, as the proposed forest land for diversion is not meant for facilities managed by the Government. There are no cases providing facilities managed Government which involve felling of trees which are less than 75 trees for Ha. u/s RoFR Act, 2006 in the proposed diversion area.

E.	A letter from the Superintending Engineer, RWS & S Circle, Kurnool certifying that all the discussions and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of members of the Gram Sabha present.	Issue of proposed diversion of forest land of 0.14 Ha. in Compt.No.235 of South Dhone Reserve forest Chintalapeta Beat, Dhone Range of Kurnool Division for laying of pipe line for drinking water was discussed in Gram Sabha and decision was taken in the quorum of minimum of the 50% of members of the concerned Gram Sabha.
F.	Obtaining the written consent or rejection of the Gram sabha to the proposal.	There are no claims existing in the area proposed for diversion, however, written consent have been obtained from Grama Sabha of U.Kothapally Gram Panchayat, Dhone Mandal of Kurnool District stating that there are no Forest Dwellers eligible under RoFR Act, 2006 in South Dhone Reserve forest and there are no any objections by the Gram Sabha.
G.	A letter from the Superintending Engineer, RWS & S Circle, Kurnool certifying that the rights of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per the section 3(1)(e) of the FRA.	There are no cases of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per the section 3 (2) of RoFR Act, 2006 in the area of South Dhone Reserve forest of Dhone Range which is proposed for diversion of over 0.14 Ha. forest land for laying of pipe line for drinking water.
H.	Any other aspect having bearing on operationalization of the FRA	There are no other issues concerned with FRA.
