Sub:-Diversion of 1.1422 ha of forest land in favour of Directorate of Higher Education Shimla for the Establishment of Himachal Sanskrit Academy, within the jurisdiction of Shimla Forest Division, Distt. Shimla, Himachal Pradesh. (Online Proposal No. FP/HP/Others/30665/2017).

As per letter no. 48-3697/2017(FCA) Dated- 03.09.2022 received from IRO, Shimla, the required information is provided as follows:

## Proper and Acceptable Justification regarding Non-site Specific Activity: 1.

It is reiterated that all the alternative for availability of non-forest land were explored, but in Himachal Pradesh, all waste land has been declared by state Govt. by 1952 notifications as forest land. "The 1952 notification issued on 15<sup>th</sup> February, 1952 and it declared the promulgation of Chapter IV of the IFA on all Government forest land and Government owned wasteland and said that all those forests and wasteland were covered by this notification". Therefore, neither private land nor any non-forest land is available for this project. (Certificate regarding non-site specific & alternative explored also attached).

Since the site, is approachable and approximately located at 20 Km from state capital Shimla that has been identified during the year 2015 for the construction of Himachal Pradesh Sanskrit Academy which is a state level institute, having Hon'ble Chief Minister of HP as Chairperson. This is the only project for promotion of Sanskrit language in the state and the beneficiaries include all the natives of state of Himachal Pradesh rather than the marked nearby villages only. It is agreed that all the alternative areas of private land or non-forest land had been explored since the people in area has small land holdings and are not ready

to give their private land, therefore, *Gram Panchayat Shakrah* has passed the resolution on 06.10.2015 and no objection for constructing the Sanskrit Academy which has already been submitted and excepted by the IRO, Shimla.

It is agreed that Diversion area is managed under Chil working circle allotted to PB-IV which was earlier grassland and Chil plantation was raised and is now having majority of Chil trees, sapling (17) and having Diameter Class –V 41 trees, Diameter Class-IV, (20 trees) and Diameter Class- III, 3 trees and having total 65 Chil trees coming in the proposed diversion area. And only one class-III trees is required to be felled during construction while rest of the trees will be retained as such.

It is therefore, requested that keeping the above facts in view and justification for non-site specific project that non-site specific activity may kindly be considered for Diversion of 1.1422 ha area for the construction of Himachal Pradesh Sanskrit Academy in the larger public interest please.

## 2. Legal Status of the CA Land is Government Common Land:

It pertain to HP Forest Department since as per working plan of Shimla Forest Division (2011-12 to 2025-26), the common land is under the possession of HP Forest Department and notification No. Rev. B.A.(3)-8/2008 Government of Himachal Pradesh Department of Revenue Dated 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2001 which has clarified that land has been mutated which has already been put to use by the Government and should not be disturbed. It is requested that the legal status of the land that it is the control and managed by Forest Department and therefore undertaking may kindly be provided to the competent authority in order to stage-II approval please.

In reply to this point user agency has submitted that there are vacant and open spaces in the proposed diversion area where the construction work as per statement provided in the layout plan, it is re-iterated that only one tree need to cut for the construction of library block and no other trees & sapling are to be felled.
