- There shall be separate cadre of staff (Teaching and Non-Teaching) in these schools with different R&P Rules.
 - Special residential allowance/free accommodation will be provided to the staff.
 - The teaching and non-teaching staff will not be transferred to any other school within the state. However, there may be a provision of inter-district migration of teacher/staff for a period of one year to exchange knowledge, cultural and resources.
- (c) One Agriculture Development Officer for the implementation of organic farming where more than 50 bighas of land is available will be provided in the school for the purpose.



**REVISED GUIDELINES IN RESPECT OF ATAL ADARSH VIDYALAYA YOJNA
(AAVY)**

Sr. No.	Previous Guidelines	Proposed amendments
1	(A) <u>Introduction and background</u> In the 1 st para i.e. introduction / background it was provided that admission /selection process will be started from nursery standard.	Admission/selection process will start from 6 th class. The Government of Himachal Pradesh has envisaged the need of setting up of residential schools known as Atal Adarsh Vidyalaya (AAV) that would bring out the best of talent from each constituency of the state of Himachal Pradesh. It was felt that children with special talent or aptitude should be provided opportunities to progress at a faster pace by making good quality education available to them irrespective of their capacity to pay for it. Such education would enable students from different areas of the constituencies to compete with their counterparts on an equal footing. Its significance lies in the selection of talented children (especially girls) as the target group and the attempt to provide them with quality education comparable to the best in a residential school system and fifty percent of the such schools will be opened only for girl students.
2	(B) <u>Objective of the Scheme</u> The Constituency where Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya is running, Atal Adarsh Vidyalaya will not be established.	It is proposed that Atal Adarsh Vidyalaya will also be opened in such constituency where Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya is already running.



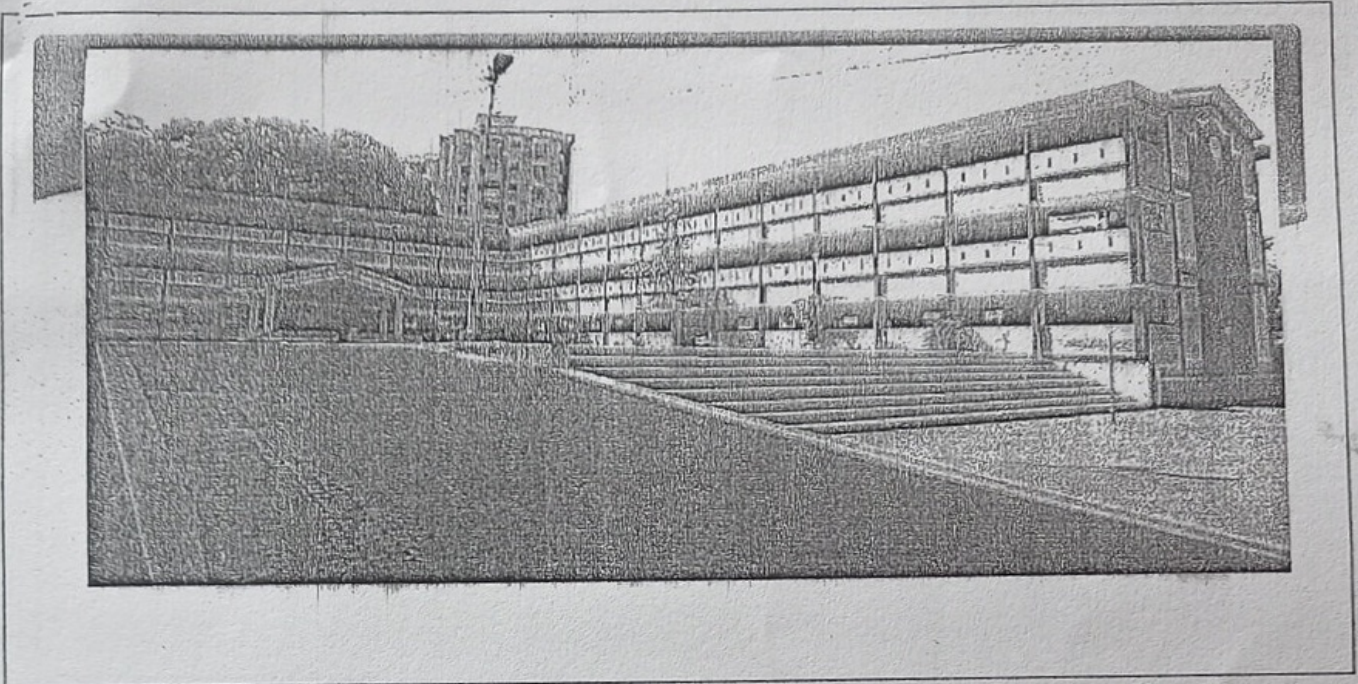



Chief Minister Residential School Scheme- an introduction...

- * Residential schools will be opened in each constituency of the State with a view to offer boarding facilities along with quality education to boys and girls of the concerned constituency.
- * In the first phase ten such schools will be opened in those constituencies in which Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya , Eklavya Model schools are not located.
- * Out of 10 Schools 5 Schools shall be exclusively for Girl Students.
- * Residential schools along with hostel facilities exclusively for girls will be opened in constituencies where female literacy rate / sex ratio is lower . Remaining 50% residential schools will be opened as per the requirement .

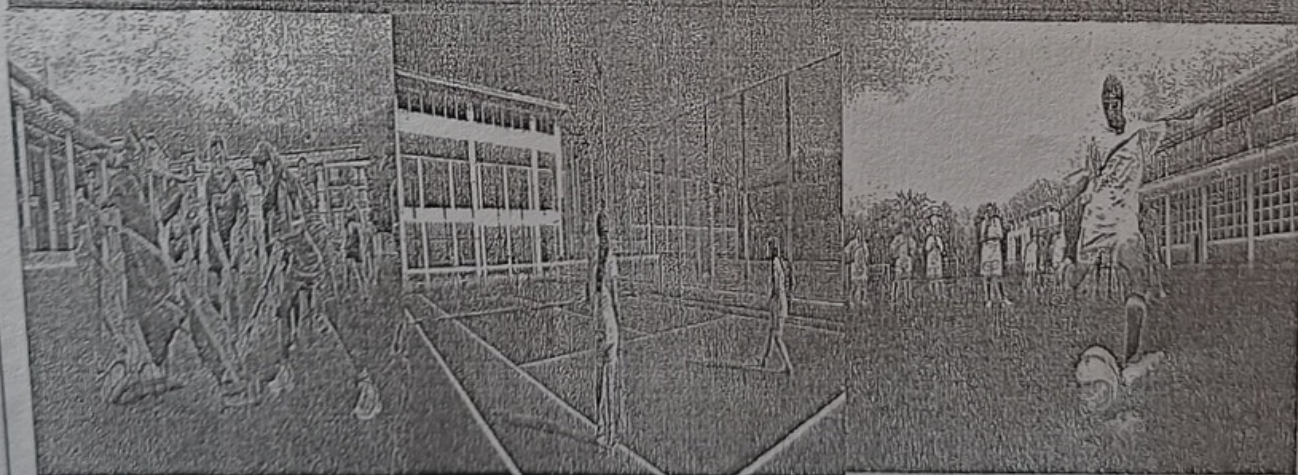

Selection Process:

Admission:

- 1) At most 50 students of the concerned Assembly Constituency will be enrolled in Class Nursery .
- 2) Child must have completed 4 years as on 31st of December.
- 3) Merit for selection shall be determined on the basis of Date of Birth as entered in the Birth Register of all concern Panchayats/Municipal Corporation in the particular constituency.

If Two or more than two Children are born on same date then their order of preference shall be decided in following manner:

- A) First preference will be given to the Child with name which appears first in the alphabetical order of their name (as per Hindi Alphabet of their name as appearing in the Birth register of the panchayat/ municipal council/ Municipal corporation.

Cont.

- B) If name of the applicants are common then name of their father shall be considered in alphabetical order for determining the merit of candidates.
- C) Even if the name of candidate's father are common then name of the mother shall be considered for determining the merit.

2) No candidate will eligible to admission in subsequent class who has not studied nursery class from that school.

3) There will be a provision for reservation of seats for SC and ST candidates in proportion to their population in the concerned constituency but not less than the national average.

5) Only candidates from the assembly constituency of the proposed residential school will be opened will be eligible to apply for admission in the school.

However, in the constituencies where the school is opened and is altered in delimitation at a later stage the old boundaries will be considered for the purpose of eligibility for admission. Separate criteria may be designed for constituencies like hard/tribal areas (Lahaul and Spiti/ Kinnaur/Bharmour/Churah etc.) keeping in view tough geographic conditions of the area.

Requirement of land

At least 50 bigha land will be required (35 bighas for hilly areas) for the construction of the proposed School in which facilities like hostel accommodation for 450 students (separate for boys and girls) in addition to creation of facilities like playground, organic farming, Centralized Mess, Auditorium, park, recreational hall students etc. keeping in view the scope of future expansion of. For speedy transfer of land to education department the following committee may be constituted:


- * SDM of the concerned constituency will be the ex officio chairman of the institute (CMRS) and following officers shall be the members of the committee.
