



I invite attention to the subject and reference cited, wherein the Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Chittoor submitted the proposals keeping in view of the guidelines forwarded by Principal Chief Conservator Forest, Guntur vide Lr.No.45921/2001-FAC, dt:07.12.2017 and also consisting of 8 points. The details of the application are as follows:-

**Point No: 01**

This type of Mineral Black Granite is available only in Forest land and it is very rare in quality which is also not yet identified in any non- forests lands.

**Point No: 02**

The present subject area lies at a distance of 45.70 Kms away from the nearest protected i.e.,Sri Venkatesawar Wild Life Sanctuary 40.70 Kms away from the nearest eco-sensitive zone and 46.50 kms away from nearest sanctuary zone.

**Point No: 03 (Details of other mining leases)**

There are no quarry leases are existing in the forest land.

**Point No: 04 (Renewals)**

Does not arise since it is a fresh proposal.

**Point No: 05 (Waste Management)**

With regard to waste management outside the mine in Non-forest land, the material available in the present applied area is vein dyke type deposit. Hence, it is necessary to win the material in the form of open-cast mining method. The waste management plan will be shown in the mining plan.

**Plan No.06. Proposed area for part of Cluster of Mines:**

The proposed area does not have contiguous boundaries. Hence preparation of cluster proposals does not arise.

**Plan No.07.**

The area not fall under any protective area/National Park/Wild Life Sanctuary/Tiger Reserve/Elephant Corridor etc.,

**Plan No.08:**

Black Granite is a Minor Mineral which is regulated by the Andhra Pradesh Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1966 and the provisions laid down under the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Amendment Act, 2015 are applicable.




