Sub: Clarification regarding the overlapping of the area applied

I had applied for the General Clearance for diversion of the Forest Land for Mining in the Villages of C N Halli Tq, Tumkur Dist under section 2(iii) of Forest Conservation Act 1980.

I received the e mail from your good office that our proposal re submitted through portal under above reference has been examined and the details of which are as follows:

1. C iv, scanned copy of the Geo referenced map of the forest land proposed to be diverted prepared by using GPS or Total station. As per the GPS readings provided by you, a small portion of the proposed area overlaps with Adjacent to the proposed area. Therefore a sketch prepared by DGPS or Total Station excluding the overlap area and got approved by the Director, Mines and Geology Department, Bengaluru should be uploaded.

I would like to state that the DGPS readings has to be issued by the Director, Mines and Geology Department, Bengaluru, there is writ petition pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka for determination of the Village boundaries and Overlapping of the areas, in this regard I had mentioned in the additional information column that the GPS readings is subject to the out come of the pending writ petition.

There will not be any changes in the Sy No. and Villages applied for the diversion of the Forest Land only DGPS readings may varies.

I request your good self to kindly process the application for General Clearance under section 2(iii) of Forest Conservation Act 1980 with the said condition, while applying under section 2(ii) we will provide the said DGPS sketch issued by the Director, Mines and Geology Department, Bengaluru
