In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (FC Division), Government of India's letter.No.11-9/98-FC (Pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that **3.308** Hectares of Forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Superintendent Engineer, TDWSP, (RWS&S), Nirmal **(14)** Villages falling in the Jurisdiction of Pitlam, Jukkal, Bichkundha & Madnoor Mandals of **Bodhan Revenue Division** & Nizamabad Division Forest Range for Construction of Structures and laying of Pipelines in **12/2 Jukkal segment**.

It is further certified that :

- The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out of the entire **3.308** hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s) and Grama Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.
- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- The proposal does not involve recognized right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities.



The Superintendent Engineer, (RWS&S), Nirmal and concerned Divisional Forest Officer, have explained the details are as stated below

It is noted that, the villagers covering in (14) Villages of Pitlam, Bichkundha & Madnoor Mandals of Nizamabad Forest Division have given consent for diversion of Forest land totaling to **3.308 Hectares**, duly conducting the Grama sabhas in the respected villages.
