Subject: Diversion of 1.465 hectare of forest land in favour of HPPWD for the construction of link road from Barnali to Upper Nari via Lower Nari (Kms. 0/000 to 3/500) within the jurisdiction of Dehra Forest Division. District Kangra, H.P.

On the basis of field report received from Conservator of Forest, (Wildlife) Dharamshala, the comments of undersigned are as under:-

1. The proposed link road from Barnali to Upper Nari via Lower Nari is away from the Pong Dam Lake Wildlife Sanctuary.
2. The aerial distance from Barnali to Pong Dam Lake WLS is 1.9 Kms, Upper Nari to Pong Lake WLS is 3.75 Kms. and from Lower Nari to Pong Lake WLS is 3.250 Kms.
3. The detail of Flora present in the above said area is Khair, Kaamal, Shisham, Kaimbal (Linea grandis), Bamboo, Kari Patta, Beul, Basuti, Khajoor, Rajain, Siris and Lucenea.
4. The detail of Fauna present in the above area is Red Jungle Fowl, Indian Peafowl, Wild Boar, Sambhar, Barking Deer, Hare, Common Myna, Babbler Spp, House Sparrow, Parakeets and Barbet Spp etc.
5. CCF WL Dharamshala further reported that the above said road was already existing as Bridle Path and it has no adverse impact on the Flora, Flora and ecology of the area.
