TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In Compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's Letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 03.08.2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes it is certified that 0.50.0 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Bodi Municipality , Bodinayakunar for construction work for check dam across Kottakudi River near Naripatty village, in Bodinayakanur Taluk which lies in Kottakudi Reserved Forest of Theni District.

It is further certified that :

- (a) Since the project area's forest block does not have any Tribal or Traditional Forest Dwellers and there are no claims under FRA-2006 the process of settlement does not arise.
- (b) Since there are other no Tribals or Traditional Forest Dwellers in the said forest block the need for placing the diversion proposal before Gram Sabha does not arise.
- (c) each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA-2006 have been carried out, and that they have their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of village(s) is enclosed as annexure . . . to annexure . . . - **NOT APPLICABLE**.
- (d) the discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present... - **NOT APPLICABLE**.
- (e) the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it....- **NOT APPLICABLE**.
- (f) The proposal does not involve recognised rights of "**Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities**".
