1. Please upload the following documents.
 - a. MAP-III (Either on normal Village map scale (1:7920) or on a larger scale (with zoom) - *one set for each village involving forest land -showing the relative positions of the forest land proposed in the present proposal and by another User Agency in Proposal No. FP/KA/WATER/31233/2018).*
 - b. Following two Consent letters/ No Object Certificates (NOC) for laying OFC:
 - i. From the Highway Authorities, and
 - ii. From the Karnataka Urban Water Supply and Drainage Board (KUWSDB).
 - c. 'Undertaking' to the effect that the all corners/ central line of forest land proposed for diversion will be physically marked on the ground with the help of temporary stone pillars / other appropriate means for verification by Forest Officers before submitting the hard copy of proposal to jurisdictional Deputy Conservator of Forests. [Note: After Stage-I approval, RCC pillars will have to be provided at all corner points and at every 20 meter interval. However, temporary stone pillars are sufficient for field verification at present.]
2. As the FC proposals involve processing/ scrutiny by Government of India, all uploaded documents should be ink-signed by the User Agency and also need to be in English. In case of non-English documents, please also upload an English translation duly authenticated/ attested by the Competent Authority/ User Agency merged with the original document into a single PDF file.
3. Please ensure that:
 - a. In order to avoid delay in the processing of the proposal because of incompleteness of the application, each of the above suggestions/ corrections is attended to and verified carefully before uploading the application online again.
 - b. Crucial information not pointed out above does not get deleted/alterd while re-submitting the application online.
 - c. No work is undertaken in forest land without FC approval.
