

Sub: - Approval of Mining Plan with Progressive Mine Closure Plan submitted under Rules of GMMC(A)R, 2015 for the lease of Black Trap mineral over an area of 01.63.39 hector (Non forest) in Survey No. 199 paiki of Village- Thordi, Taluka- Savarkundla, District- Amreli. (Gujarat).

In exercise of the power conferred vide Government of Gujarat Notification No. MMR/102014/979/CHH dated 18/07/2015 and letter No.: MMR/102014/979/CHH dated 30/07/2015 from Industries and Mines department, Govt. of Gujarat read under Rule 3F to 3V of GMMC(A)R, 2015, I hereby approve the above said Mining Plan. This approval is subject to the following conditions:

- I. The Mining Plan is approved without prejudice to any other laws applicable to the mining lease from time to time whether made by the Central Government, State Government or any other authority.
- II. This approval of the Mining Plan does not in any way imply the approval of the Government in terms of any other provisions of the Mines & Mineral (Development in Regulation) Amendment Act, 2015 and rules made there under and any other laws including the forest Conservation Act, 1980, Environment Protection Act, 1986 and the rules made there under. It is clarified that this approval of Mining Plan is subject to the forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Forest Conservation Rules, 1981 and other relevant statutes, orders and guidelines as may be applicable to the lease area from time to time.
- III. The Mining Plan is approved without prejudice to any order or direction from any court of competent jurisdiction.

- IV. Provisions of the Mines Act, 1952 and Rules and Regulations made there under including submission of notice of opening, appointment of manager and other statutory officials as required by the Mines Act, 1952, and sub-sequent rules shall be complied with.
- V. The execution of mining plan shall be subjected to vacation of prohibitory orders/ notices, if any.
- VI. The lessee shall submit "Financial Assurance" under Rule 3 K of GMMC(A)R, 2015 before executing the lease deed. The mining operation cannot be commenced before submission of financial assurance to the competent authority.
- VII. If anything is found to be concealed as required by the Mines Act in the contents of the mining plan and the proposal for rectification has not been made, the approval shall be deemed to have been withdrawn with immediate effect.
- VIII. As regards to mining operations and blasting is concerned, the Lessee has to follow provisions of Metalliferous Mines Regulations, 1961 and directives issued by Director General Mines Safety from time to time.
- IX. This approval is as per the detail/Plan submitted by your RQP. Any deviation from actual submission, will be subject to immediate rejection of the Mining Plan.
