Subject: Grant of permission under the Haryana Govt. (Communication and Connectivity Infrastructure) , 2017 ( Modified and amended time to time) for erection of Roof top tower(RTT)/Roof Top Pole (RTP) /Ground based Mast (GBM)/ Ground based Tower (GBT) in Respect of following CAF IDs in District Rewari:

The permission is hereby granted for erection of RTT/RTP/GBM/GBT on the land mentioned as per subject with the following conditions:-

1. This permission is subject to the Rules, Regulations & conditions mentioned in Communication and Connectivity Infrastructure Policy, 2017 and Modified and amended time to time and the guidelines of Department of Telecommunication of India issued from time to time.
2. This permission does not provide any immunity from any other Rules & Regulations of any other State or Central Govt. Department as applicable on the site. The responsibility of keeping emission under the Air pollution act and any up-gradation required within the norms, is the responsibility of ISP/telecom operator and regulating authority in this regard is Department of Telecommunication for installation of mobile towers.
3. As per guidelines of Department of Telecommunications (DOT), a copy of application for Standing Advisory Committee on Frequency Allocation (SACFA) clearance acknowledged by WPC Wing of Deptt. of Telecommunication, Govt. of India with registration number for the individual location will be submitted along with the application for this tower in the concerned urban local body and SACFA clearance, when obtained will be submitted within 6 months of granting permission. The self-declaration in this regard will be submitted by the applicant. In case of existing mobile towers, the SACFA clearance, wherever available, will be submitted along with the application to the concerned appropriate authority, failing the same, the Haryana Govt. shall initiate the necessary action as per the policy of the settlement for not abiding the decision.

4. If, any dispute arises with respect to the Structural Safety, Emission of Radiations, Electric Installations, Erection and any damage cause to the property where the pole/tower is to be installed and other adjoining properties, shall be dealt by the applicant company itself and the Urban local body which has granted such permission shall not be a party in the matter at any stage.
5. The applicant/concerned company shall take special precaution for the safety, lightning and electric installation along with tower/pole structure erection, as per guidelines already issued by concerned authorities in this regard.
6. At any stage if it has been found by the appropriate authority as per the clause no. 3.26 of the policy that the applicant Reliance JioInfocomm Ltd., Gurugram has made any misrepresentation or any fraudulent information has been provided to the department for grant of the permission of this Mobile Tower, this permission for erection of the Mobile Tower will automatically stands null and void and thus becomes in-fructuous.
7. This permission for erection of this Mobile Tower is valid up to 15 years from the date of issue of this letter or co terminus with the expiry of the ISP/telecom operator license issued by the Department of Telecommunication, Government of India, subject to fulfillment of conditions regarding power of attorney, rent agreement, no objection certificate from the concerned departments including fire and forest.
8. The licensees and registered IP-Is shall be responsible for any damage to life or property caused by the Tower, in case it is proven that the damage has been caused solely due to Tower.
9. The operator shall ensure the safety guidelines issued by DOT in this regard.
10. The complaints relating to EMF emissions, if any will be referred to Department of Telecommunication / TERM Cell, Government of India.

In case of breach of any condition of the above permission, dated 24-5-2021 and conditions referred above, this permission issued herewith shall be treated as revoked.
