Velugumalai Forest Block in Khammam Taluk and District Declared as a Reserved Forest

(G.O Ms. No. 745, Forests and Rural Development (Forest - II) 15th December , 1977)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 15 of Andhra Pradesh Forest Act, 1967 (Act 1 of 1967) the Governor of Andhra Pradesh declares the Forest described in the schedule below (delineated in the map kept in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad) to be a reserved forest with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette.

Boundaries

North :- Starting from station No. 1 on the North - West corner of the Forest which is a permanent cairn constructed for the purpose and also it is the South - West corner of S. No. 164 of Velugumalai village runs in North - Easterly direction to Station No. 10 with the following magnetic bearings and distances.

 B) Rights of way admitted within the forest

The following cart – tracks are admitted within the forests as public rights of ways to a width of 13' for the use of men cattle and bullock carts.

R.W I:- the Cart track from Pattagunta to Kodmur village.

It enters the forest between station No. 42 and 43 and running through the forest in a southerly direction over a distance of 0.8 Kms and leaves the forest between stations Nos 25 and 26.

R.W II:- The cart track from Pattagunta to Vandamam .

It enters the forest between station Nos 42 and 43 and runs through the forest in easterly and south – easterly direction over a distance of 0.4 Kms and leaves the forest between stations Nos 17 and 18
