A solid height e.g. 12 represents the approximate height in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Under stones etc. in this area usually appear under July to December.

Thin shells are common throughout the area, only the thinnest ones have been shown.

Commonly made and continued in this area are generally suitable in dry areas. Permission to use these strong metals is required from Brighton authorities.

Common stones along coast are 5000 feet and some 1000 feet above in dry areas.

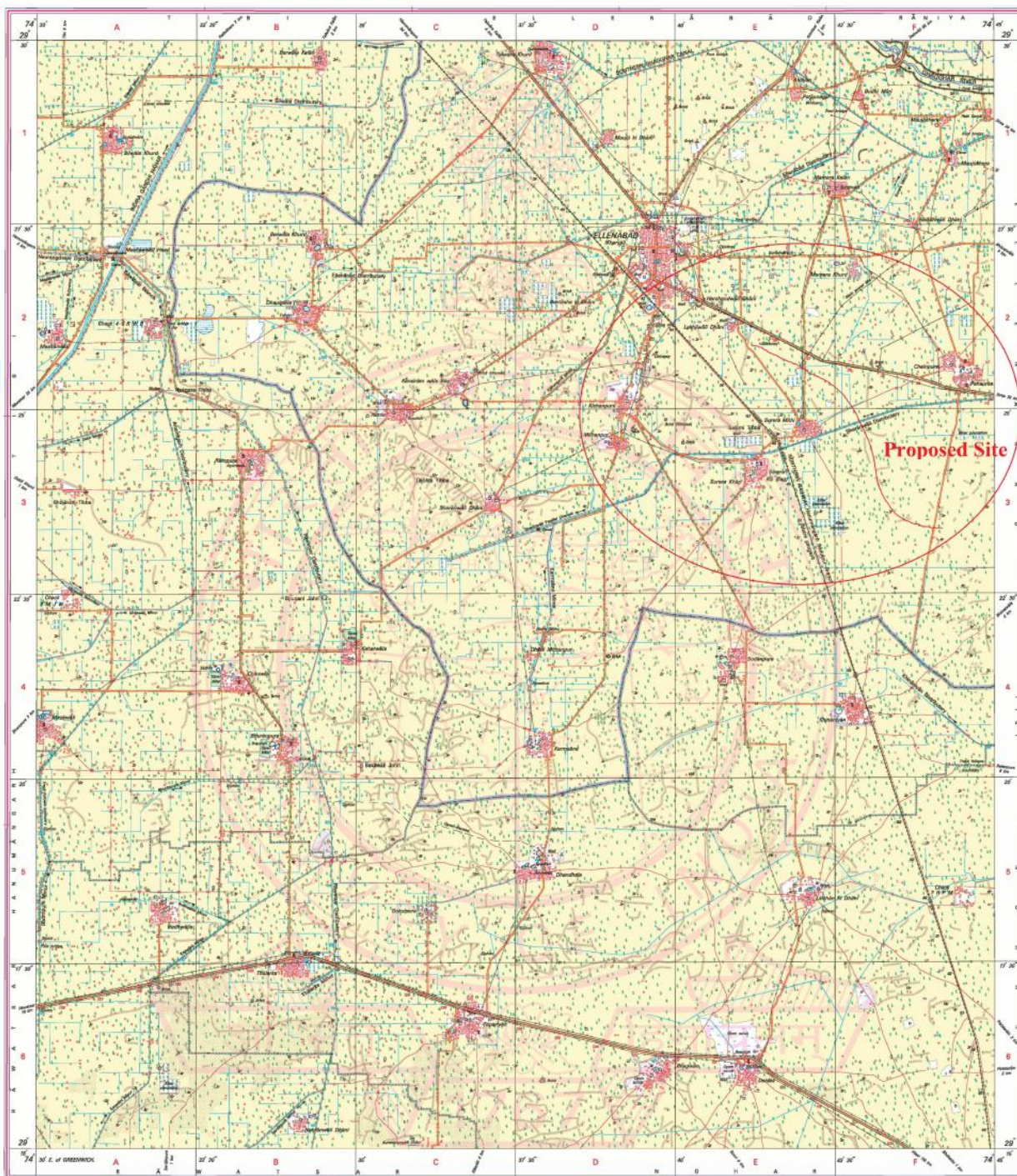
