

**Short narrative of the proposal and project/scheme for which the forest land is required.**

1. Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad invited bids for sale of assets of their Cement Plants of UPSCCL (under liquidation) located at Dalla, Churk & Gurma in District Sonebhadra and Chunar in District Mirzapur through a global tender. JAL with a bid of Rs.459 Crores was declared the highest bidder and made payment of the entire bid amount to the Official Liquidator, UP & Uttarakhand. Consequent upon deposit of the final installment on 11.10.2006 the sale of the assets of UPSCCL (in Liquidation) was confirmed by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature of Allahabad in favour of Jaiprakash Associates Ltd. (JAL).
2. As per the commitment in the MOI forming part of the tender document and its Section 5 containing Relief's & Concessions for the successful bidder, the leases of the following mines were to be renewed and transferred to the successful bidder:

3. Consequent upon confirmation of sale vide order dated 11/12.10.2006 of Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, following areas were transferred to JAL as Mining leases and forest area were excluded:-

The above balance areas earmarked as Forest above had been later excluded from Forest vide Notification No. 4952/14-2-2008-20(17)/2008 Lucknow dated 25.11.2008 under Section 20 of IFA. However, NGT vide its order dated 4.05.2016 has cancelled the above Notification of Section 20 and asked the following forest land to be transferred under provision of IFA 1980.

**As per NGT order dated 30 may 2016-**

“In addition the Applicant has also prayed that a direction be issued that all recommendations of the State Government and all approvals of the Central Government under section 2 of the Forest Conservation Act and renewal and transfer of all the mining leases by the State Government be carried out in a time bound manner and not later than 3 months from the date of mining of the application any the applicant complete in all respect.


We find the as this matter has been pending from 2006 onwards, there should be a direction for disposal of the recommendations under Section 2 of the Forest Conversation Act and renewal and transfer of mining lease, if any, be carried out within a period of 6 months from the date of filling of the Application. Application is disposed of.”

Out of the total 1083.785 area as per NGT order, the following area are essential for operation of JP super plant

JAL also has established one more cement plant, i.e. Jaypee Super Cement Plant having capacity of 2.01 MTPA clinkerization unit. The Plant now located on land where UPSCL Crusher was existing and running since 1976 which later came under the purview of above NGT Order. For Jaypee Super Cement Plant, there is requirement of 95.070 ha. forest land. The limestone requirement of JP super plant was envisaged to be met from captive mines of Dalla Cement Factory to optimize limestone reserve.

In addition, for both Dalla Cement Factory and Jaypee Super Cement Plant there is also requirement of 20.804 ha. land where Township, Hospital, Schools etc. are located since 1976 which has now come under the provision of Forest Act.
