Sub: Compliance of letter mentioned in Reference-2 against our proposal to divert 4.9969Hectare of forest land for the project aimed at supplying 16MVA power to CCL Karo Konar Project

Dear Sir,

With reference to your office's letter as per reference -2, regarding our proposal to divert 4.9969 Hectare of forest land for the project aimed at supplying 16MVA power to CCL Karo Konar Project, points raised therein have been addressed as mentioned below:

Ι	The KML file of the proposed CA site is not uploaded	CD containing the KML file of the proposed CA site is submitted with this letter.
11	The KML of file examined alternative routes of transmission line	CD containing the KML file of the alternative routes of transmission line is submitted with this letter.
111	964 trees were enumerated in the forest land proposed for diversion, but all do not require felling. Details of trees proposed for felling may be uploaded in online application.	Total 964 trees required to be felled as per earlier uploaded tree enumeration list.
IV	Detailed component -wise breakup of proposed forest land for diversion is not mentioned in column in part-I (B-2.4) of online application	Component wise break up of proposed forest land is submitted in part-I (B-2.4) of online application.
V	As the proposed route is apparently crossing an existing set of railway tracks in forest, the NOC from railway, the primary agency to whom the piece of forest land was diverted previously, is mandatory, Similarly, transmission line is proposed over an apparent chequered area of BTPS (or others) in forest too, therefore NOC is solicited from them also. DFO needs to assert that these are no encroachment on the forest land	NOC from railway for railway track crossing has been obtained and uploaded. The mentioned chequered area belongs to M/s CCL; NOC has been obtained and uploaded on the Parivesh portal.
VI	As per the Geo-spatial analysis, it appears that the transmission line is passing through the plotted area (near 23°47'18.80" N, 85°53'50.47" E). Hence, the DFO may clarify the actual status of the said plotted area.	As gathered, the mentioned plotted area belongs to M/s CCL; NOC has been obtained and uploaded on the Parivesh portal.
VII ,	The transmission line abruptly originates from the forest land leaving a marginal area unmarked at its northern end. The entire area should be appropriately marked to get included in the proposal.	The transmission line does not originate from the forest land. The transmission line is originating from DVC BTPS switchyard and terminating at proposed Konar CHP substation of M/s CCL. The signed copy from M/s CCL for the location of Konar CHP substation is attached.

In view of the above, it is kindly requested to process our proposal to utilize 4.9969 Hectare of forest land for the project aimed at supplying 16MVA power to CCL Karo Konar Project.
