
Sir.

For the purpose of exploration of Hydrocarbon within the Doomdooma Mining Lease Area, we have scheduled to drill one well in the Upper Dihing Reserve Forest (WB) under Digboi Forest Range of Digboi Forest Division named as 'DGR'.

- The area required by us is shown in the attached site plan Drawing No.OIL/9980 and in 2.0 the scale of 1:50,000 of the topographical map of location DGT within Digboi Forest Range, the details of the which is given below:

- As such you are hereby requested to initiate necessary action for diversion of the aforesaid reserve forest area for non-forestry purpose i.e. for drilling a well at Location "DGR" under the provision of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980. We also request you to handover the plot of land to us at the earliest enabling us to take up the required civil engineering job for taking up the drilling works as per the programme of the company. Duly filled in part I with respect to the dereservation of the land involved in the said location is enclosed herewith for necessary action at your end, please.
- We also confirm that OIL INDIA LIMITED shall take adequate pollution control measures and take necessary protection as per the provisions of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. environmental clearance from the appropriate authority with respect to the Environmental Impact Assessment Notification of 14th September 2006 (EIA 2006) will also be obtained and produced in due course of time. (Before taking over possession of the site.)



- 5.0 In case the well is abandoned the area shall be returned to the Forest Department.
- 6.0 We shall be grateful if you will kindly initiate necessary action on priority basis to handover the above plot of forest land to OIL INDIA LIMITED to start the civil construction jobs.

- Oil India Ltd. is a Public Sector undertaking engaged in exploration. Production and transportation of Crude Oil and Natural Gas. The drilling location site is selected after Geological studies and interpretation of data obtained from seismic survey. There is indication of strong possibilities of presence of Hydrocarbon in location DGR which falls in forest area. Since the location site is scientifically determined based on geological and seismic data, it is not possible to change the site.

(v) Cost – benefit analysis(to be enclosed)

Oil India Ltd. is a Public Sector undertaking giving C/B Ratio devoted to exploration and production of oil and gas. Produdction of oil is of immense importance to the Govt. from both defence and economic Production of oil benefits the state Govt. as well as the Central Govt. as it receives substantial royalty. Local inhabitants benefit greatly from growth of oil production. Communication facilities are developed with the growth of Oil Industries, local youth get job in the companies.

Site Inspection Report

Certified that, I have inspected the OIL drilling location at DGT located at Upper Dehing Reserve Forest (West Block) under Digboi Range of this Division on 05/11/2013 During my site inspection I found that the total area of the drilling location at DGT is 2.463 (Say 5.0 hect). The site selected for drilling purposes is not the harbour of any endangered flora and fauna. Movement over out of endangered species through the site may happen. But that will not cause any disturb to the flora and fauna. The site is not protected for any archeological or heritage site or defense establishment or any other important monuments. The proposed site is 5 Km. away from the Dehing Patkai Protected Forests. There is no elephant corridor in an around the proposed site. In the same site the OIL carried out drilling exercises earlier. Presently the Oil authority is proposing to carry out the drilling activity in the same location. Now the total forest land proposed for diversion for drilling purposes is 2.463 (Say 5.0 hect). The drilling location site has been selected after geological studies and interpretation of data obtained from seismic survey. Hence it is unavoidable. No any work in violation of Forest Protection Act has also been carried out by the user agency in that location.
