SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

A proposal has been received by this office from P.M.G.S.Y Irrigation Division Uttarkashi for diversion under FCA -1980 of 0.398 hectares of forest land non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for construction of Chinyalisaur to Kot-Bagi motor road km-7 to 10 till Kot village. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 4-7-2014.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a BF/PF/un-closed/protect forest measuring 0.398 ha.
