

The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has been entrusted with the assignment of Development of Economic Corridors, Inter-corridors and feeder routes and Coastal road primarily to improve the efficiency of freight movement in India under BharatmalaPariyojna Lot-3/Odisha & Jharkhand/Package-2 having length of proposed alignment 463.265 km (which is totally green field) which starts from near Abhanpur (ch. 0.000)/ch. 61.600 of proposed Raipur-Durg Bypass and ends at Vishakhapatnam bypass (ch.463.265) of Existing section of SH-38.

(iii) forward his findings in this regard to the Conservator of Forests

(f) the entire process referred to in clause (e) shall be completed by the District Collector within the time period stipulated in these rules for grant of in-principle approval under the Act to the proposal.
