Allocated allotment of additional capacity is subject to the
following conditions

1. Company shall enter into an agreement with Government within 3 months from the date of issue of Government order, failing which the allotment order shall automatically lapse. The Company would have to apply de-novo for capacity allocation their being no obligation on the Government to allot capacity at the same site. There shall also be no refund of the deposit received by NREDL.

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2. Company shall carry out site specific wind speed measurement at 10 meters and hub height levels for a minimum of 6 months during the wind season (April to September) to prepare a DPR on the basis of micro-siting using standard tools and submit the same to KVICI for approval.
3. The company shall install one wind mast for every wind farm of 5 MW capacity or part thereof for wind speed measurement on a permanent basis to compare the actual performance of wind farm in relation to the certified power curve of the WEG.

4. Development shall be assisted to obtain permission from the concerned authorities to install the wind monitoring mast at the allotted place to conduct the on site wind measurements and to carry out land survey for the preparation of detailed Project Report.
5. Three 3 copies of DPR are to be submitted to KVICI for the scrutiny and approval at least 3 months before the start of construction of wind farm and obtain the NOC from Government accordingly.
6. The company shall obtain necessary statutory clearances from the respective authorities of Forest, Revenue, and other relevant Government Departments wherever necessary. KVICI shall assist the Developer wherever necessary.
7. The deposit paid shall be adjusted towards the DPR processing fee payable to KREDL.
8. KPTCL is permitted to enter into a wheeling and banking agreement or power purchase agreements on the standard terms and conditions.

The company would have to apply de-novo for capacity allocation there being no obligation on the Government to allot capacity at the same site. There shall also be no refund of the deposit received by K.R.E.D.L.
- b) Company shall carry out site specific wind speed measurement at 10 meters and hub height levels for a minimum of 6 months during the wind season (April to September) and prepare a DPR on the basis of micro-siting using standard models and submit the same to KREEL for approval.
- c) The Company shall install one wind mast for every wind farm of 5 MW capacity or part thereof for wind speed measurement on a permanent basis to compare the actual performance of wind farm in relation to the certified power curve of the WEG.
- d) Capacity range of WEGs Approx. number of WEGs in a 5 MW wind farm. No. of wind mast to be established.

- e) Three 3 copies of DPR are to be submitted to KREDL for the scrutiny and approval before start of construction of wind farm.

The Company shall obtain necessary statutory clearances from the respective authorities of Forest, Revenue and other relevant Government Departments wherever necessary.

The deposit paid shall be adjusted towards the DPR processing fee to be paid by the project allottee to the K.R.E.D.L.
