SUMMARY OF PROJECT

OIL INDIA LIMITED (OIL), a Government of India Navaratna enterprise, is currently engaged in exploration, production and transportation of hydrocarbons primarily in Upper Assam, South-Eastern part of Arunachal Pradesh and Mizoram in the North Eastern part of the country.

- 2.0 The Ningru Petroleum Mining Lease (PML) block covers 427.058 sq km in Changlang and Namsai districts of Arunachal Pradesh. The same was formally granted to OIL by Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh on 04.05.2018.
- 3.0 Before expiry of the Ningru PML in Nov'2003, OIL applied for renewal of the PML to MoP&NG in 2002 as recommended by Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh. Though MoP&NG accorded its approval on the re-grant of the PML in the year 2004, the same could not be formally granted by Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh in absence of prior approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- 4.0 OIL accordingly submitted its Forest Clearance proposal under Section 2(iii) of F(C) Act, 1980, which was granted by MoEF&CC on 26.07.2017 and consequently, the PML was formally granted by Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh on 04.05.2018 for 20 (years) w.e.f. 27.11.2003 referred above.
- 5.0 During the earlier tenure of Ningru PML from 27.11.1983 to 26.11.2003, Forest Clearance under Section 2(ii) of F(C) Act, 1980 was obtained for Forest Clearance for Loc-KUP & Loc- KUL covering a total of 7.111 ha of forestland within the said Ningru PML block.
- 6.0 The subject proposal is accordingly towards renewal of said Forest Clearance for Loc-KUP & Loc- KUL. Drilling of additional wells KUAU, KUAX, KUAV & Loc-G from Loc-KUP and KUAW, KUAT & Loc. E & F from Loc-KUL have been planned in near future.
