The village wise abstract of forest land must tally with the plot wise total of the forest land proposed for diversion. Thus, it needs to be rectified and correct land schedule should be submitted. | The extent of forest land proposed for diversion of village Talokonanda,Dolita,Bala,Bardhana, Sirikuan, Uchabali, Jyotipur & Sadangi have been rectified with respect to their village wise abstract and plot wise total area.
