I along with Forest Range Officer, Kushnepally and concerned staff have inspected the area proposed for Excavation of left flank main canal and 8-R Distributory for Neelwai Medium Irrigation Project (Package No.12) in favour of Executive Engineer, Irrigation Department, MIP Division Mancherial on 07.12.2017 the proposed canal is passing through the Reserve Forest block Girelly-Ext of Kushnepally Range in Bellampally division with different widths. The details of proposed diverted area Compartment wise are as follows.




The total area required for diversion in Bellampally division for Excavation of left flank main canal is 18.083 Ha.

The User Agency has already carried out construction work of canal in the following patches in the Reserve Forest over an extent of **13.829 Ha** of area violating the FC Act 1980. The details are as follows.

- Cement concrete work of canal with a length of 2225.45 Mtrs over an extent of 8.725
 Ha of area has already been carried out in Girelly and Girelly Ext Reserved Forest
 Blocks by the Irrigation department long back.
- Earth Work excavation with a length of 1147 Mtrs over an extent of 5.104 Ha of area has already been carried out in Girelly and Girelly Ext Reserved Forest Blocks by the Irrigation department long back.





During the Field inspection it has come to know that, in the proposed diversion area some farmers tribals were issued ROFR certificates. The list of ROFR certificate holders is as follows.

In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree species, protected archaeological, Heritage site, defense establishment or any other important monument are found. The area is having different types of vegetation, having 0.1 to 0.4 density.

The proposed area is not falling in any National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere reserve, Tiger reserve, Elephant corridor, etc. But, the aerial distance from Pranahitha Black Buck Sanctuary of Kotapally Range of Chennur division is 6.64 Kms.



The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without any alternatives for the project.
