

The area of 9.33 Ha in Kotapally Range and 0.6 Ha violation in Neelwai Range i.e total of 9.93 Ha violation report submitted to the P.C.C.F, TS, Hyd regarding violation of the Act vide this office Rc.No.3588/2016-S2B, Dt: 21.08.2017.
