Part-II Column 11. Site inspection report of the D.C.F.

The site under proposal was visited on 16.05.2017. The proposed version of retail out-let (Petrol-Pump) which is declared as protected forest vide GOB notification no 190E dated 16.11.1994. The road side land is 0.0165 ha. Site GPS reading N- 25°54'12.636" E- 86°41'44.482" N- 25°54'12.327" E- 86°41'43.12" & proposal out-let M/s Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd. before establishment of retail out-let (Petrol-Pump) located on East Parwati Ramchandra Petroleum distance in 5km & West side Anant Satrudhan fuel center, Tiri distance in 3km. The proposed forest area is a habitat of any endangered species of Flora or fauna. No any geological/ heritage site/ defense establishment or any others important monument was found located inside the proposed area. All the alternatives were explored and it was found that the proposed forest area is the barest minimum area as per the requirement of the project of the user agency. The agency has not done any work in violation of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 on the site.
