
Inspection note, finding and recommendations with reasons.

The proposed site was inspected on 09-09-2017 The Deputy Conservator of Forest and subordinate staffs, were present & helped during the inspection. The factul details regarding the Proposed site and consequent findings are stated below:-

- 1- The Proposal site is situated along NH-77at Sitamarhi on Plot no- 999,1000, 1001&1002 Mauza-Yogibana, Khata No- 59, & 159, Thana- 200, Dist. Sitamarhi Which is a protected Forest vide Government of Bihar Notification No- 190E dated 16-02-1994.
- 2- The user agency Proposed for diversion of 0.0446 Ha of forest land in order to use entry & exist of the vechiles at Proposed site.
- 3- There are no trees present of the site. There are no rare/endangered/unique species of flora & fauna found in the area. No archaeological site is present in and around the Proposed site.
- 4- The user agency has not done any work on the site. The width of entry & exit each would be 7.5 m, including the flank.

On the basis of the recommendation of the Deputy Conservator of Forests and the inspection made by me, the proposal may be accepted due to following reasons :-

- 1- The denisity of the road side Protected Forest is very low. The acceptance of the proposal, as it entails, provision of compensatory afforestation along the road side, as is costumany, may help to increase forest density & green cover.
- 2- The forest area involved in this project is only 0.0446 Ha, which is bare minimum & is quite negligible.
