

Site Inspection Report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam for diversion of 6.53 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Sapparla to Gollapalli of G.K.Veedhi Mandal on 09.01.2021.



Inspected the proposed area for diversion of 6.53 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Sapparla to Gollapalli of G.K.Veedhi Mandal on 09.01.2021 which is passing through Compt.no.1054, 1057, 1059, 1084, 1085, 1088 & 1043 of Sileru RL in Lankapakala, Sapparla Beats, Sapparla

Section in R.V.Nagar Range and A.Dharakonda Beat, Dharakonda Section of Sileru Range along with Range staff and officials of the User agency i.e., Executive Engineer, PRI Division, Paderu.

- The total length of proposed road is 12.50 Km. of which 8,706.66 m. in 3 Bits is falling in RF. The width proposed by user agency is 7.50 m. Thus, the total area required to be diverted for formation road including construction of culverts (12 no.) is 6.53 ha. ($8,706.66 \times 7.50 \text{ m.} = 65,300 \text{ m}^2$ i.e., 6.53 ha.).
- There are 72 no. of miscellaneous trees are falling within the proposed width of the road as reported by the Forest Range Officer, R.V.Nagar. The density of the vegetation in the vicinity is about 0.6. There is already an existing old cart road/ pathway of width about 5 to 6 m.

The proposed road is essential to tribal villages/ hamlets for their connectivity and essential services like medical facilities, education, marketing of agricultural produce etc. With reference to alternate C.A. land, the User agency has to hand over alternate land fit for C.A. to forest department for "Compensatory Afforestation (C.A.)".

The proposed road is recommended for an area of **6.53 ha.** for diversion of forest land in Compt.no.1054, 1057, 1059, 1084, 1085, 1088 & 1043 of Sileru RL in

14. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.
15. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC guideline F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dt.29.01.2018.
16. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulated from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
17. The compliance report shall be uploaded on *e-portal* (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).

The required forest area is unavoidable for the project and due to this project there is no threat to the local flora, fauna and there is no archeological heritage importance in this locality.
