

SITE INSPECTION REPORT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF NELYA – DHAULA ROAD FROM 0.91 KM TO 36.514 KM AND LINK ROAD TO BHAWAN POST (NET LENGTH – 35.604 KM) BY BRO UNDER TAWANG DISTRICT OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH.


I have personally inspected the proposed site for diversion of 89.298 ha. of forest land for construction of Nelya – Dhaula road from 0.91 km to 36.514 km and link road to Bhawan post (net length – 35.604 km). The project is linear and stretches over a distance of 35.604 km and falls under Tawang Forest Division.

The findings of my inspection are as listed below:

1. The forest of the area falls under Sub Alpine Forest and Montane Temperate Forest with density varying from 1 to 4 in a scale of 10.
2. The area doesn't form a part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant corridor, or any other notified forests.
3. The area doesn't form a part of habitat for rare/endangered species of flora & fauna.
4. There is no protected archaeological heritage site/ defence establishment or any other important monument in the proposed alignment.
5. The requirement of forestland as proposed is the barest minimum for the proposed project as compared to other alternative alignments.
6. No work in violation of the Act has been carried out.

In view of above and considering the strategic importance of the project, it may be considered favourably.
