The vehicular traffic is also negligible and hence in view of protection of forest and requirement of up gradation of road, it is recommended the width of road for 6 Mtrs instead of 7.50 Mtrs as proposed by the User agency and the diversion area reduced to 0.223926 Ha. As per justification given by user agency and the field conditions, the barest minimum and unavoidable area for the project is <b>0.223926 Ha</b> .
