The said NH 63 road passes through the forest area where there is movement of Tiger and other wildlife. Since it is going to be upgraded as National Highway, the movement of vehicles and the speed will be more which causes disturbance to wildlife and also they will not be able to cross the highway. This may also lead to road kills and fragmentation of the forest for wildlife movement. Hence under passes are to be constructed by UA for easy movement of wildlife. In view of the movement of Tiger and other wildlife, the widening and strengthening of NH 63 to Two Lane is recommended subject to following conditions: 1. The UA shall construct the under passes of 30.00m length and 5.00 m height at said identified (04) locations in Mancherial division and (01) location in Chennur division jurisdiction forests at the wildlife crossing points for easy movement of wildlife at following locations.
