

**SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELLOW THE RANK OF DCF
(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)**

A proposal has been received by this office from Commandant KLP Radhabari for diversion (Under FCA-1980) of 12.5 ha forest land in Jungle Mahal Mouza, Sheet No. 11, Plot No. 03 (RS) in the district of Jalpaiguri for establishment of BN H.Q. . The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on 07.10.2021. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is 12.50 Ha of revenue forest (Bad jungle in Sabik Kissam) in Jalpaiguri District. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable.
