RECOMMENDATION REPORT OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR, SRIVILLIPUTHUR - MEGAMALAI TIGER RESERVE (SMTR), SRIVILLIPUTHUR

I inspected the area proposed for diversion on 09.02.2022 along with Forest Range Officer, Saptur; Forester (Saptur section) and one forest guard (Mallapuram beat). The area requested by user agency for laying of optical fibre cable (OFC) along the road side from Muthalamparai Village to Mallapuram Village through Mallapuram beat forest area in Saptur Reserved Forest for a length of 6.23 Km.

1. ECOLOGICAL IMPORTANCE OF THE PROPOSED SITE FOR DIVERSION

- a. Part of Srivilliputhur-Megamalai Tiger Reserve
- b. Part of Agasthiyar Biosphere Landscape
- c. Part of elephant reserve No. 7
- d. Erstwhile Grizzled Squirrel Wildlife Sanctuary

2. AREA DESCRIPTION AND ITS IMPORTANCE

The entire project falls inside the Mallapuram beat of Saptur RF all along Mallapuram – Mayiladumparai road for which right is admitted as per government letter number G.O. (Ms) No. 14 dated 08.02.2021. The road passes through the buffer area of the Tiger which involves both Sanctuary and non-santuary area. The OFC passes through Sanctuary area for a distance of 4.3 km and in non-santuary area for remaining 0.7 km (Map 1). Several minor seasonal streams cross the road and there are some huge rocks are also present in some places (Table 2). The proposed site has several endangered wildlife species (Table 1).

3. GENERAL REMARKS

The site proposed for laying OFC is home for several endangered species as mentioned above (Table 1). However, damaged caused to flora and fauna is very minimal as the project is proposed along the road from Muthalamparai Village to Mallapuram Village through Saptur Reserved Forest. This will enable transportation of equipment to lay OFC through the road and also facilitate easy operation and maintenance in future. The project site doesn't have any important monuments which has archaeological importance/ heritage site/ defence establishment etc.

4. LEGAL PROVISIONS

- a. As per Ministry of Environment and Forests Wildlife Division, New Delhi letter number F.No: 6-10/2011 WL dated 19.12.2012, it is mandatory to obtain approval of Standing Committee of NBWL for any activities falling inside Tiger Reserve.
- b. The project requires Forest clearance under Forest Conservation Act, 1980
- c. According to Hand book of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and Forest conservation rules, 2003(guidelines and clarifications) published by Ministry of Environment and Forests and Climate Change, 2019 Chapter 2, paragraph 2.5(i) (b) CA shall be raised and maintained at the cost of user agency on degraded forest land twice in extent of forest area diverted in the case of laying optical fiber lines.

Hence, after carefully considering the impact of the project on local biodiversity, the project recommended for Wild Life Clearance under Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 and Forest Clearance under Forest Conservation Act, 1980.


