


## Inspection Report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Giridih East Forest Division

The undersigned inspected the forest areas proposed for diversion of Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dharma Pipeline (JHBDPL) Project on 06.12.2018. The proposed pipeline passes through notified forest areas and Jungle-Jhari land (deemed forest) of different Mouja whose details are as below:-

The crop density of these notified forest area and deemed forest area for this linear forest diversion is varied from 0.1 to 0.3. There are undergrowth of Palas, Semal, Dumar, Mahua, and Bamboo etc. The proposed area measuring of 3.2344 ha. is prone to erosion. No rare, endangered or unique species of flora and fauna are found in the proposed diversion area. No any protected archaeological/heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monuments is located in proposed diversion areas. Although the proposed site is not notified corridor of migratory elephants, it is regular path of movement of migratory elephants.

Moreover, the proposed site was inspected physically and found to be diverted as the alternatives proposed line shown in the Toposheet could encompassed more forest areas. The entire tract consists of least no. of trees to be cut.
