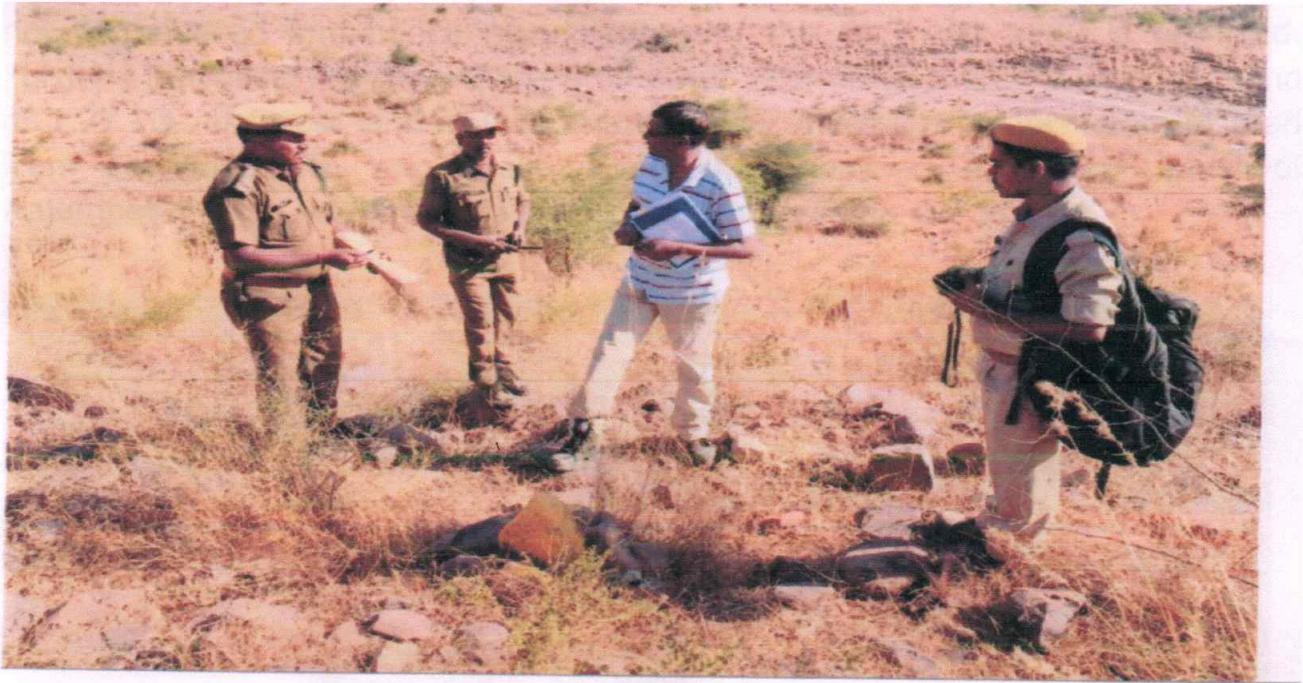


**Site inspection Report of Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Division, Rajampet in Compt.No.868 of Pulapathur R.L extent 1.77 Ha. proposed for diversion for Formation of road from Baggidipalli to Yakaropalli village of Pulapathur Grama Panchayat of Rajampet Mandal.**

Inspected the Forest area in Compt.No.868 of Pulapathur R.L on 03.02.2018 proposed for Diversion over an extent o 1.77 Ha. for formation of road from Baggidipalli to Yakaropalli village of Pulapathur Gramapanchayat of Rajampet Mandal in favour of Executive Engineer, PRI Division, Rajampet along with Forest Range Officer, Rajampet and Deputy Range Officer, S.R.Palem Section and Renuthala Beat staff. The area proposed for diversion is having scrub jungle growth with abundant of Boda grass. The flora present in the area are Sandra, Gotika, Rela, Uddi and Reppala etc.,. The forest area proposed for diversion is hilly terrain having gentle slope. The density of vegetation is 0.1 to 0.2. The fauna present in the area are Rabbits, Cats etc.,

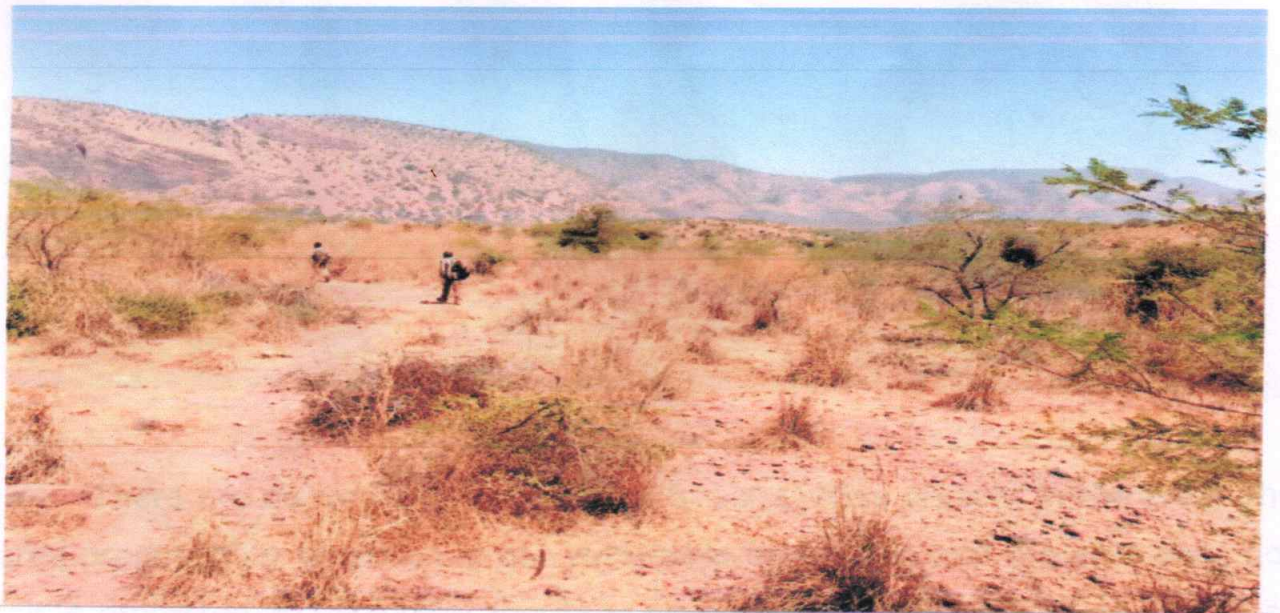



There are no rare and endangered forest species present in the area. The area proposed for diversion is not vulnerable for erosion and the area does not fall in protected archeological /heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monument. The Forest area proposed for diversion does not fall in Wildlife Sanctuary, Natural Parks and Eco-sensitive zone/Corridor.





The distance from the nearest Sri Penusila Narasimha Wildlife Sanctuary of Kadapa Forest Division is 10.105 Kms and it is 25.743 Kms from Sri Penusila Narasimha Wildlife Sanctuary of Rajampet Wildlife Division. The road work was not commenced and hence no violations of the F(c) Act, 1980 is occurred. Further, it is observed that, there is no other alternative than the proposed land of 1.77 Ha. of forest land in Pulapathur R.L for diversion for formation of road from Baggidipalli to Yakaropalli village of Pulapathur Grama Panchayat of Rajampet mandal and it is barest minimum required for the project.
