

Site Inspection Report

The site inspection of the forest land involved in the proposal has been carried out by the Divisional Forest Officer, Seraikela Forest Division, Seraikela on date 08.02.2019.

On inspection of the site, it was found that the forest land required by the User Agency is 7.5425 ha. The document of proposed forest land is verified by respective authority and relating documents of the divisional records is as flows :-

The proposed land for diversion is unavoidable & barest minimum for the project. It is mostly sal forest along with some mixed forest. There are 4350 no. of trees under the proposed ROW. The average density of trees in proposed ROW is 0.4. The proposed forest land is undulating and needs soil and moisture conservation works to control soil erosion. Elephant, Monkey, Indian hare, jackal, Wild boar are the major wild life present in the forest area proposed for diversion.

The forest land of proposed alignment has been temporarily demarcated. The user agency has not violated the provision of forest conservation act and no work has been started on the forest land.
