The Proposed project area is passing through notified protected forest of Biharsharif-Bakhitiyarpur road, Biharsharif-Rajgir and Biharsharif-Ekangarsarai Telhara road in Nalanda District is sotified as Protected Forest by Environment and Forest Department, Government of Bihar through vide SO. No. 1647 E, dated 20.12.1994 in which the present proposal for total about 0.078349 ha (as per seld verification) is proposed for diversion. The crop raiding Nilgai is also present adjoining areas of the Proposed project. Since the project area is prosed in the outer area of the Protected forest and does not have much influence on the animal movement.

This is the bare minimum forest land required for the project. The amount realized from the agency in the form of NPV shall be utilized for conservation, protection, and management of forest division.

The proposed area involves diversion of 0.078349 ha in Nalanda Forest Division, Bihar Sharif.

This is the barest minimum of forest land required for the instant project and has no other alternative to pass. Diversion of these forest land areas for this project (non forestry activity) may not much affect local flora of the area. The User Agency has violated the prescribed provisions of the Act. The work been stopped immediately after taking legal action. Further violations were not reported. The provisions have to be imposed against the violations.

In the light of the above mentioned facts and keeping the fact that the laying of OFC cable to wide network for CCTV camera surveillance under Biharsharif smart city project in Nalanda District required. So as per the prescribed provisions I recommend positively for the approval of this proposal Penal provisions of the Act. This instant proposal for diversion of forest land may be approved
