The diversion of 2.4227 Ha of forest land for the road work R/F Kosagutta to Yapalguda of Pembi (M) in Nirmal District is Recommended subject to the following: a) Since there is a good alternative road connectivity by constructing one bridge over Kaddam River from Shetpally to Yapalguda, which will also reduce the road length, the User agency can avoid the proposed road passing through the core area of Kawal Tiger Reserve for a length about 4.0378 Kilometers, which will be fragmenting the typical tiger habitat into two segments. Or Alternatively if necessary, formation of said BT road from "R/F Kosagutta to Yapalguda of Pembi (M)" is recommended subject to construction of animal passages of height of 2.5 M and length of 10-15 m at mentioned (09) locations for the passage of wild animals across the road from one side to other side, besides taking up all other wild life Mitigative Measures. b) All the debris at the site of construction of under passes shall be removed immediately after construction. c) The animal passages and culverts across the streams shall be maintained and desilting shall be done once in 04 months to prevent sand / silt deposition for easy wildlife movement. d) Kindling of any fire in forest shall not be allowed and work of upgradation shall be done between 9AM to 4PM only.

- e) Speed breakers shall be provided for every 500m length to control the speed as it is in Tiger Reserve.
- f) Signages on speed limit and wildlife movement/ protection shall be placed at every 500m on both sides.
