


### Site Inspection Report

I have inspected the proposed site on 08.03.2019 for diversion of 28.299 ha (26.699 ha for mining + 1.60 ha for approach road) of forest land of M.L.No.2559 of M/s MSPL Limited, Hospet.

The Proposed area for diversion for approach road is located in Swamymalai Forest Block (Section-4 notified vide Notification No. FFD-29, FAF-84 Dated: 28.02.1985) in Sandur Taluk, Bellary District, Karnataka.

As per the CEC digitization sketch the extent of lease area is 26.71 hectares, Out of this, 0.011 hectares overlapped with M/s. Mysore Minerals Limited. The user agency has agreed to reduce the overlapped area an extent of 0.011 hectares. After the reducing the area concluded as 26.699 hectares. The user agency submitted the proposal approach road for 1.60 (A-B for 0.37 ha + A1-D for 1.23 ha) hectares. The same has been marked in the sketch. Therefore, the Forest Clearance may be proposed over an extent **28.299** ha (26.699 ha for mining + 1.60 ha for approach road) hectares only.

The proposed forest land is not part of National Park, wildlife sanctuary, biosphere reserve, tiger reserve, elephant corridor, etc. However, proposed area is 26.30 km distance from the Daroji Bear Sanctuary and 25.80 kms distance from Eco-sensitive zone area of Daroji Bear Sanctuary and 14.97 kms distance from the Gudekote Bear Sanctuary and 10.15 kms distance from Eco-sensitive zone area of Gudekote Daroji Bear Sanctuary
