



Sirsa for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 0.0156 ha. of forest land. The project envisages use of forest land for access to Dhan Guru Nanak Weigh Bridge along Khairekan-Mattar Road km 15.935 LHS at village Alikan, under Forest Division & Distt. Sirsa.

- 1 The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on 17.02.2020.
- 2 On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest area measuring 0.0156 ha.
- 3 The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
