The proposed area involves diversion of **25.65 Ha** in Gaya Forest Division, Gaya. This is the bare minimum of forest land required for the project and has no other alternative to bye-pass. Diversion of this forest land area for the project (Non-Forestry activity) may not much affect the local flora of the area. The User Agency has not violated the prescribed provisions of the Act till the date of inspection.

In light of the above mentioned facts and keeping the cognizance that Gaya District falls under the Naxal Affected area and as per the prescribed provisions, I recommend positively for the approval of this proposal. Therefore this proposal for diversion of forest land may be approved with necessary conditions and directions.
