

## SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA-1980)

A proposal has been received by this office from Senior Manger (Retail Sales), Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Divisional Office Bareilly (U.P) for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 0.198204 Ha of Protected forest land for non forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of protected forest land to be diverted for entry/exit approach to IOCL Retail Outlet on Jahanabad-Pilibhit Road NH-30 (Old NH-74) in Km No. 291 (CH. No. 290.093, RHS) at Khasra No. 442, Village:-Lalauri, Tehsil:-Pilibhit, District:-Pilibhit (Uttar Pradesh).

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 24.04,2022

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a protected forest land measuring area of 0.198204 Ha.
